One ornate sarcophagus shaped box, approximately five and a half inches in length, two inches wide, and two inches deep. The box lid features the figure of Anubis with crossed arms and a series of Egyptian hieroglyphics carved onto the exterior.

## Artifact Translation of Hieroglyphics:

Seeker of Wisdom,

Servant (son) of Yugr (Yoag) Setheth,

Deliverer of the people (slaves) of the water,

Bearer of the spirits of Nar-Loth-Hotep,

Child of Thoth,

Seeker of Wisdom.
